The bedrooms need decorating and we haven't had the broken windowpanes replaced yet in the conservatory. We need to fix the gate and repair the path — it looks dreadful when you arrive."

⑤评分时,如拼写错误较多,书写较差,以至影响交际,将分数降低一个档次。
